American Animals Federation to host Groundhog Day events

What: The American Animals Federation has partnered with four zoos to host a Groundhog Day Celebration on Jan. 31. The event will provide children with educational facts and a make believe 'groundhog performance' of the ritual. There will also be an outdoor activity and a chance to pet a real groundhog.

Who: The AAF is a 501c3 nonprofit that raises awareness of North American animals. The AAF has partnered with zoos in Dallas, Texas; Kansas City, Missouri; Minneapolis, Minnesota; and Lincoln, Nebraska. The event is for children ages 5-12 and their parents or guardians.
